Example Subjects:

- Oral Hygiene for Orthodontic Patients
- Instrument Care and Sterilisation
- Developing Staff Protocols
- Patient Instruction Information
- Case Study of Patient(s) Treated
- Waiting Room Information
- Write up of a Particular Project or System Device
e.g. Have you recently reorganised your stock?

Conditions of Entry:

- The prize is open to all dental nurses currently working in orthodontics in hospitals, community, specialist practices and general practices. Membership of the Orthodontic National Group is not a requirement.
- Folders are limited to a maximum of 10 sides of A4. Any folders exceeding this amount will not be put forward for judging. This will not include the title page and a page of entrant's details. The latter page is to be removable so that the presentation will remain anonymous for judging.
- Work will be judged on the following criteria: Technical Content, Innovation, Nurse Involvement and Overall Presentation.
- Closing date for applications. Folders to be submitted to TOC no later than Friday 8th August 2008. Entries should be sent to Nicky Thompson, TOC (Nurses Prize), The Old Church, Collins Street, Avonmouth Village, Bristol BS11 9JJ.
- Winners will be announced at the BOC in Brighton on Monday 15th September 2008 and notified in writing by 17th October 2008. Please ensure name, address and contact telephone number are clearly marked on submitted work. Patient's permission must be obtained where relevant.
